"Why am I different from my brothers?" the poor little duckling is crying. "Why are they teasing me? Nobody loves me!"

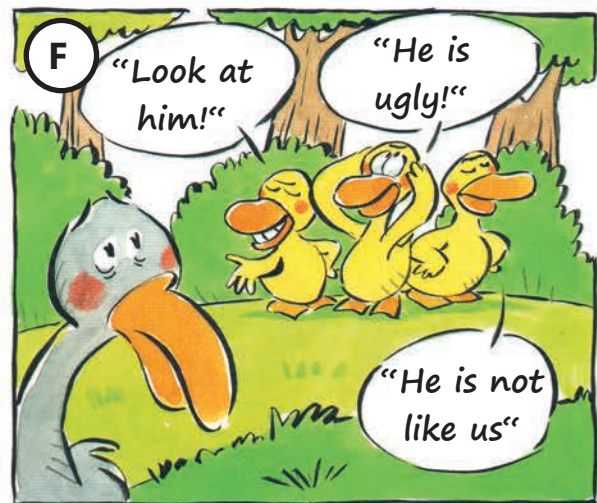
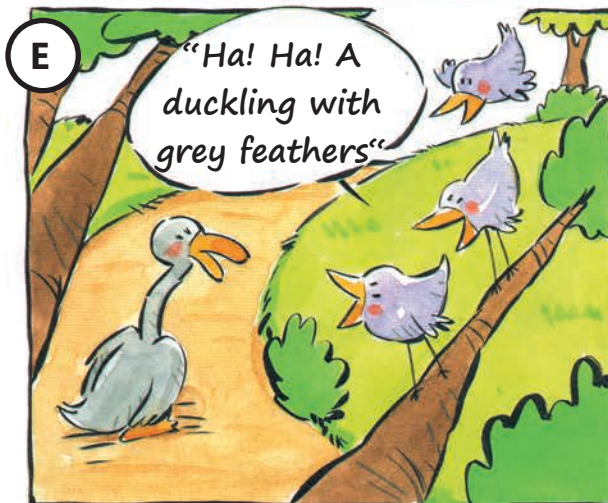
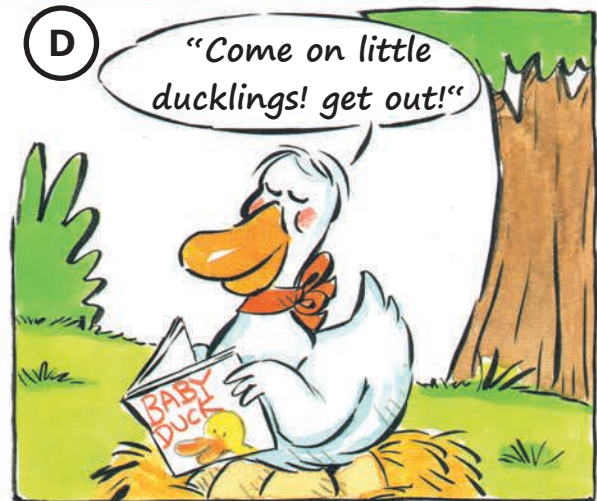
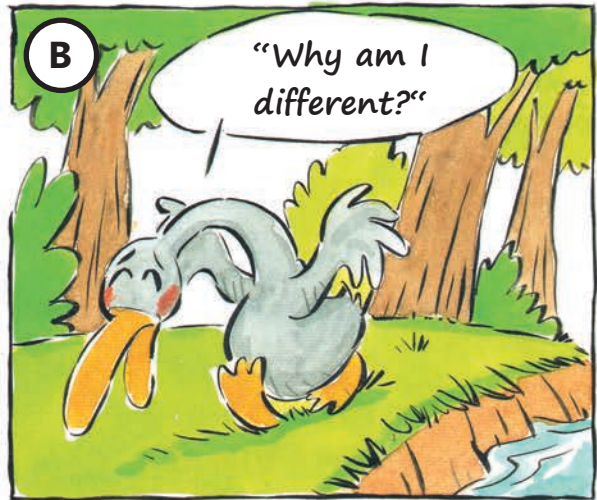
