PRESENT SIMPLE

I **read** books.

He **goes** to work.

Planes **fly** high.

every day/week/month/year; daily; weekly; on Sundays/Mondays/etc.

2 прислівниками частоти:

- **always** (завжди)
- **usually** (зазвичай)
- **often** (часто)
- **sometimes** (деколи)
- **never** (ніколи)

We go to school *every day*. They *often* play tennis. She *is never* late.

Прийменник	Значення	Приклади
at	о/у (момент часу) на (свята)	at 6 pm, at noon, at the moment at Christmas, at Easter
in	у (роки, пори року, місяці)	in 2005, in winter, in May
on	у (дні та дати)	on Monday, on my birthday, on 4th May
