

PRESENT SIMPLE

- 1 обставинами часу: every day/week/month/ year; daily; weekly; on Sundays/Mondays/etc.
- 2 прислівниками частоти:
 - always (завжди)
 - usually (зазвичай)
 - often (часто)
 - sometimes (деколи)
 - never (ніколи)






